Procedures to making SEED POTS

- 1. Start with a section of newspaper.
- 2. Cut the newspaper section in half. You can also cut several layers at once, to save time, but use only one sheet/single layer per pot.
- 3. Cut it in half again, and fold it in half.
- 4. Take a water bottle. Roll the paper around it, leaving about an inch overhang at one end where you will fold it in for the bottom. Don't roll too tightly or it will be too hard to get the bottle out later.
- 5. Fold the bottom in, as if you were wrapping a present. make sure the bottle is all covered and not visible.
- 6. Tape the bottom shut using biodegradable tape.
- 7. Take out the bottle. Turning it right side up, fold in the edges all around the top.
- 8. Once the seed pot is completed you put soil in it with a seed and plant it in the ground.

 Eventually both the newspaper and the tape will disintegrate allowing for the seed to become a flower.
