- A plant is judged a weed by its abundance, not its mere occurrence, and by its aggressiveness.





















Other

- Boron: 8oz borax in 4 oz of warm water added to 2.5 gal water, spray. Do NOT repeat. Creeping Charlie is sensitive to boron.
- Iron: Fiesta = 4.43% iron chelate, tank mixed, applied at about 60 degrees (can harm grass at warmer temps) can kill within 2 days. Limit 2 applications/year

Post-emergent, Selective Selective Nonselective 2,4-D: broad lvd glyphosate: dicamba: broad lvd everything it MCPP: broad lvd touches MSMA, DMSA: grasses (monosodium methyl arsenate)
